In a hospital setting, safety and infection prevention are of utmost importance. To support the health and well-being of our patients, please keep the following guidelines in mind when donating:

<u>All</u> donations <u>must</u> be <u>scheduled</u>, please do not just drop off donations. Thank you

- All donated items must be **NEW** (store-bought and in original packaging) and **SAFE** (non-toxic)
- Due to infection control guidelines for all our patients, we **CANNOT** accept used or "previously loved" items, riding toys or food.
- We **CANNOT** accept items that have been stored or an extended period of time, are no longer clean/fresh, or have a strong odor (perfume, cigarette, etc.)
- We CANNOT accept HOMEMADE items like hats, blankets or cards.
- Due to patient privacy, donors are not allowed to personally deliver gifts to patients.
- PLEASE DO NOT GIFT WRAP the donation.
- PLEASE DO NOT put LABELS or TAGS on gifts.
