## CHANGING BATTERIES TUTORIAL

UNION PACIFIC 4005, 3985, 844

(PF Control Channel 4, Red or Blue)

- 1. Stop Train with PF Controller.
- 2. Lift coal plate cover off of tender car.
- 3. Turn off, then extract the battery box. (Big Power Button)
- 4. Unscrew lid and replace batteries.
- 5. Re-screw lid and remount in tender car. (Adjust wires as needed.)
- 6. Turn on.
- 7. Place coal cover back on tender car.
- 8. Resume operation.

Be sure to reattach any piece that may have become loose. If unsure, leave stray pieces by PowerOwl battery charging station.

If train slows to a crawl or stops with fresh batteries, it may have overheated and needs to cool down.

## YELLOW LEAD-LINED DIESEL

(PU Controller, Bluetooth)

- 1. Stop Train with PU Controller.
- 2. Lift back cover off of train.
- 3. Turn off both controller and train, then extract the battery box. (Big Power Button)
- 4. Unscrew lid and replace batteries.
- 5. Re-screw lid and remount in train. (Adjust wires as needed.)
- 6. Turn on both train and controller to sync.
- 7. Place cover back on train.
- 8. Resume operation.

## SANTA FE 2021

- 1. Stop Train with PU Controller or Phone.
- 2. Lift rear shell cover off of train, delicately.
- 3. Turn off both controller and train, then extract the battery box. (Big Power Button)
- 4. Unscrew lid and replace batteries.
- 5. Re-screw lid and remount in train. (Adjust wires as needed.)
- 6. Turn on both train and controller or phone to sync.
- 7. Place cover shell back on train.
- 8. Resume operation.

NOTE: Santa Fe uses an L motor and may run with the Crocodile setting on the Powered Up App on the phone. If using the PU controller, operator will have to keep the button pressed down.
